- **1. Discussion/Presentation re purchase of a Type 1 Engine: Motion** by McNall to authorize purchase of engine from Salem up to \$25K pending reception of maintenance records from Salem and approval of those records by Connor McKibben and Reeves, seconded by Goter; unanimously approved.

- 3. Discussion of direction of MFD
- **4. Spending Authority: Motion** by McNall to increase McKibben's spending limit to \$2,500 on his own authority and purchases between \$2501 to \$5000 requires Board president's approval, anything greater than \$5K requires full board approval; seconded by Rubin; unanimously approved.

McNall requests permission to increase McKibben's credit card limit to \$2,500 (up from \$1K); approved by board.
